

219 STUDENT OUTREACH PROGRAM

Background

The Division believes a variety of approaches should be used to meet the individual needs of students and to help students complete their high school diploma. Each Outreach Program is unique and is designed to meet the individual needs of its students. The goal of the program is to enable students to work towards meeting the requirements leading to the completion of a high school diploma.

Procedures

1. The student's right of participation in the Outreach Program can be terminated for failure to comply with program expectations.
 - a. High school students applying to complete courses through the Outreach Program must seek the approval of their local school administration.
 - b. The Division may establish operational guidelines and student/parent expectations/responsibilities regarding the program.
