

230 DISTANCE EDUCATION

Background

Canadian Rockies School Division recognizes that, in some instances, students may not be able to access specific courses to complete their High School Program. On the recommendation of the Principal and under his/her signature, the Division authorizes students to participate in distance courses such as those offered through the Alberta Distance Learning Centre.

Procedures

1. Distance Education is recognized as a supplementary and/or alternate form of program delivery in the Division.
2. Applications shall be made through the Principal.
3. Because Distance Education courses are assigned the same credit value as classroom-instructed courses, students are expected to apply themselves with the same diligence.
4. The student shall be responsible for all fees associated with the program unless excused by the Principal. However, upon successful completion of the Alberta Distance Learning program, the student may be eligible to apply for reimbursement of the cost of the program and materials.
5. In all cases, the student seeking reimbursement, shall apply in writing to the principal, providing evidence of successful completion of the course.
