223 Human Sexuality Education

Background

Human sexuality education is offered in Grade 4 to Grade 9 as a mandatory component of the program of studies and Senior High School Life Management (CALM 20 Course).

The Division recognizes a parent's right of supervision in these areas and therefore their right to request their child not attend such classes.

Procedures

- 1. In advance of topics related to Human Sexuality (as per the Alberta Education Programs of Study) being taught, the teacher will notify parents of:
 - a. the content,
 - b. and if a guest instructor may be involved
- 2. Parent(s) may, via a form or email, opt out, by:
 - a. Exempting their student(s) from any part of the unit.
 - b. Exempting their student(s) from all of the unit by notifying the teacher at least two (2) school days before the instruction is scheduled.
- 3. Alternate learning experiences shall be provided for those students who are exempted from this instruction.
- 4. The above does not apply to incidental or indirect references to human sexuality in a course, a program of study, instruction or exercise or in the use of instructional materials.
