345 HAZING

Background

The Canadian Rockies School Division forbids the practice known as "hazing," that is, the subjection of incoming students to various forms of punishments or indignities.

Procedures

- 1. The subjection of incoming students to hazing is forbidden, whether:
 - a. On the school premises,
 - b. In connection with school activities on or off the school premises,
 - c. To and from school.
- 2. For introducing new students to a school, "welcome activities" rather than "frosh" activities are encouraged.
- 3. In determining what constitutes hazing and welcome activities, the decision of the school administration shall be final.
- 4. At the discretion of the Principal, any student participating in hazing may be suspended or expelled from school.
