All aspects of Occupational Health and Safety are covered in the CRPS Occupational Health and Safety Manual.

Compliance with the Canadian Rockies School Division health and safety program and the Alberta Occupational Health and Safety legislation is necessary to maintain a healthy and safe work environment. As with any program, corrective disciplinary measures may be required to deal with non-compliance issues. Furthermore, all non-compliance issues shall be documented and placed within the individuals personnel file.

In general, the following disciplinary actions will be considered depending on the frequency and severity of the offence:

- Verbal warning
- 2. Written warning
- 3. Suspension
- 4. Termination
