5.2 <u>Reconfiguration of Exshaw and Canmore Schools</u>

Reconfiguration Exshaw and Canmore Schools 415-1920 Motion: A. Rheaume

It is of utmost importance to CRPS Board of Trustees, senior administration and CRPS staff to maintain Exshaw School in its present configuration - with all the supports currently in place. It is our aim to work with Stoney Education Authority (SEA) to maintain the relationship with all Stoney Nakoda parents who make the choice to enroll their children in CRPS.

In the event that CRPS is unable to obtain adequate Federal funding to continue to support Indigenous students attending Exshaw School the board will review the various options as presented by senior administration:

Option

• Maintain Exshaw school in its present configuration

Option

- reconfigure Exshaw School to a local community school for grades K-3
- to provide for the education needs of students under the tuition agreement with Stoney Education Authority at the following schools:
 - Elizabeth Rummel School,
 - Lawrence Grassi Middle School
 - Canmore Collegiate High School
- Limits would be placed on the number of students which could be supported through the tuition agreement

Option

- Closure of Exshaw School
- Tuition agreement with SEA for students from Stoney Nakoda Nation to attend Canmore schools
- Limits would be placed on the number of students which could be supported through the tuition agreement

Option

- Close Exshaw School
- Do not enter into a tuition agreement with SEA (no First Nations students from the Nation would be permitted to attend CRPS schools)
