After careful consultation, the Board of Trustees and Senior Administration of Canadian Rockies Public Schools have decided not to volunteer to pilot the K-6 draft curriculum.

Given the reality that the pandemic will likely continue into the summer and possibly continue to impact schools next year, we feel it is in the best interests of our staff and students to opt out of this process. While we know it is important to have our contributions heard, which is normally achieved through a piloting process, we do not want to introduce any additional pressures onto our students and professional staff next year.
