RE: COVID-19 Communication CCHS

Dear Families of Canadian Rockies Public Schools,

Today we were informed that a student has been identified as a direct contact of a person who has tested positive for COVID-19. As a precautionary measure, one class at CCHS will be moving to At-Home-Learning starting Wednesday January 13, 2021. The student will obtain a COVID-19 test as soon as possible and once the results are known the school administration will communicate next steps with the families of this class. Parents of the students in this class have been contacted by the school administration.

It would be prudent for parents to keep their children home from school if they know there has been a potential exposure to COVID-19, until such time as they are able to determine if the exposure has led to an infection. Children who have had direct contact with a positive case of COVID-19 must remain home and isolate for 14 days. If you receive any information pertaining to you or a family member regarding exposure or potential exposure to COVID-19, please inform your school administration as soon as possible.

Out of respect for the privacy of any families or children involved, we are unable to provide any further information about our most recent situation. Please refrain from phoning either the school or division office with regard to this matter.

A deep cleaning and sanitization of the classrooms will be occurring. Our facilities staff will continue to clean and disinfect the school daily as per our ongoing practice.

We remind parents/guardians of students, as well as any staff/visitors/volunteers, to please remain vigilant and monitor for any signs or symptoms of COVID-19.
