CRPS was informed today that two siblings at Alpenglow School were in direct contact with an individual who tested positive for COVID-19. As a precautionary measure, we have closed both classrooms for the remainder of the week. A deep cleaning and sanitization of both classrooms will be occurring. Our facilities staff will continue to clean and disinfect daily as per our ongoing practice. We are planning on reopening classes on Monday morning. Parents of the students in the two classes affected will be notified of next steps by Sunday via email by school administration.

Out of respect for the privacy of any families or children involved, we are unable to provide any further information.

AHS are experiencing a backlog in relation to contact tracing. If you receive information pertaining to you or a family member regarding exposure or potential exposure to COVID-19, please inform your school administration as soon as possible.
