570 PUBLIC SOLICITATIONS IN SCHOOLS

Except by express permission of the Superintendent, the following activities are forbidden:

- An activity on Division property in school hours which results in financial gain from students to any outside individual or commercial enterprise (such as the sale or distribution of goods or tickets and the taking of collections). This prohibition does not extend to activities promoted by a school, Parent Council, or community association in connection with a student function which has the approval of the Principal.
- 2. Any fund-raising or promotion by outside organizations or individuals involving projects in which students are compelled to participate.
- 3. Any voluntary student fund-raising promotion scheme by an outside organization or individual which does not have the approval of the Principal.
- 4. Any program provided for students during school hours within school or elsewhere for which a charge is made. This prohibition does not extend to system-wide programs with Board approval, such as the swimming-water safety program and the outdoor education program.
- 5. The provision of lists of the names and addresses of teachers or students to any outside individual, company or organization.
- 6. The distribution of material or information which promotes a particular religion or dogma.
