Dear Families of Canadian Rockies Public Schools:

We were informed today that one individual within Exshaw School has tested positive for COVID-19. As a result, we moved one Exshaw class to online learning yesterday, June 7<sup>th</sup>. Impacted families have been notified by school administration. Alberta Health Services (AHS) will be contacting the parents/guardians of students, as well as any staff/visitors/volunteers who may have been in close contact with the case.

Out of respect for the privacy of any families or children involved, we are unable to provide any further information about our most recent situation. Please refrain from phoning either the school or division office with regard to this matter.

A deep cleaning and sanitization of classrooms will be occurring. Our facilities staff will continue to clean and disinfect the school daily as per our ongoing practice.

We remind parents/guardians of students, as well as any staff/visitors/volunteers, to please remain vigilant and monitor for any signs or symptoms of COVID-19.
