RE: Exshaw School At Home Learning

Dear Families of Canadian Rockies Public Schools:

Over the weekend, we were informed that a number of individuals within Exshaw School have tested positive for COVID-19. We are unable to provide an exact number of positive cases at this time as we are awaiting more information from Alberta Health Services. In consultation with Alberta Education we have moved Exshaw School to at home learning as of today, June 14th, for the safety of both students and staff. This directive will be in effect for the remainder of the school year and impacted families have been notified by school administration. Alberta Health Services (AHS) will be contacting the parents/guardians of students, as well as any staff/visitors/volunteers who may have been in close contact with the case.

Additionally, Stoney Education Authority is ceasing bus transportation to Exshaw school but transportation will remain from the Nation to other CRPS schools who have Stoney Nation students in attendance at other CRPS schools.

A deep cleaning and sanitization of the entire school will be occurring by our facilities staff.

We remind parents/guardians of students, as well as any staff/visitors/volunteers, to please remain vigilant and monitor for any signs or symptoms of COVID-19.
