

Outdoor Learning Program Assistants

The applicant is required to be onsite during the entirety of the course. The successful applicant will be compensated on a day rate that will be based on experience and certification. Staff accommodation is a possibility while employed with Canadian Rockies Public Schools.

Duties and Responsibilities

- 1. Support teaching staff during educational activities and lessons.
- 2. Provide support and supervision during activities on and off site and lead activities.
- 3. Help to create a positive experiential learning environment through team building activities.
- 4. Support meal preparations, particularly breakfast and dinners, including routine cleaning of the kitchen.

Certifications

- 2. Other relevant outdoor certifications and experience will be considered an asset (i.e Paddling Certification/Swift Water Rescue, OCC Field Leader, AST Level 1 or 2, Class 4 driver's license etc.).
