



## Outdoor Learning Program Instructor

The ideal candidate will have experience in outdoor pursuits, outdoor experiential learning, and exemplify a dynamic, collaborative style in an environment of positive interaction with all partners. The applicant is required to be onsite during the entirety of the course. Staff accommodation is a possibility while employed with Canadian Rockies Public Schools.

### **Duties and Responsibilities:**

1. Support teaching staff during educational activities and lessons.
2. Provide support and supervision during activities on and off site and lead activities.
3. Help to create a positive experiential learning environment through team building activities.
4. Support meal preparations, particularly breakfast and dinners, including routine cleaning of the kitchen.

2. Other relevant outdoor certifications and experience will be considered an asset (i.e Paddling Certification/Swift Water Rescue, OCC Field Leader, AST Level 1 or 2, Class 4 driver's license etc.).
